COURSE OUTLINE

SHB30416 – Certificate III in Hairdressing (Apprenticeship)



DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of hairdressers who use a range of well-developed sales, consultation and technical skills and knowledge to provide a broad range of hairdressing services to clients.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is for an apprentice hairdresser who has a Training Agreement (apprenticeship) with an employer. (Eligible or non eligible for funding)

OR Fullfee paying student who has a workplace to use for assessment.

Students need to complete an online literacy and numeracy assessment to show that they have an appropriate level of LLN skills to participate successfully in the course and to identify any additional support needs.

2021 FEES

This course is subsidised by the NT Government. The NT subsidy applies to eligible domestic students living in the NT and is subject to available places. (places are limited)

ASSESSMENT

Assessments vary with each unit. You will be provided with an assessment guide.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

Students can apply for RPL during pre-enrolment or after enrolment. Students are provided with an RPL Self-Assessment before application and followed through with and an initial interview with an assessor.
